



Rotary Club of Airlie Beach Inc., Invite all young drivers to attend **R.A.D.E** Rotary Advanced Driving Event

Dear Students & Parents,

Vehicle accidents are the major killer of our youth between the ages of 17 and 25 years of age.

The Rotary Club of Airlie Beach Inc is proud to sponsor an initiative to have all year twelve students from our region complete "Advanced Driver Training" before leaving school.

To this end, **John Fraser Fleet and Driver Consultancy** from Brisbane are bringing two accredited advanced driving instructors to Proserpine from the 17 to 20 October to conduct Advanced Driver Training for our students. For Proserpine State High and Bowen State High, the 17th is a pupil free day so we suggest students utilise this opportunity to not miss out on school.

The normal cost of this training is \$320.00 per person; however, the Rotary Club of Airlie Beach Inc is subsidising the program to the extent that it will only cost \$40.00 for each student to participate in the program. This is an exceptional opportunity for your child to gain this skill which may one day save their life or the lives of their loved ones... for a mere **\$40.00...**

Students must wear protective sun safe clothing, ie. Hats, shirts and enclosed footwear.

The program consists of one full day's training. The following timetable will be run each day commencing 17 October and concluding 20 October. A maximum of 20 students will be participating on any one day.

9. 00 am. Meet at tuck shop and you will be taken to a classroom for 2 hour theory lesson.

The theory consists of:

- Analysis of risk of road crashes
 - Legal matters pertaining to drivers including dangerous use of a motor vehicle.
 - Vehicle Energy, potential for damage, types of crashes.
 - Advanced Driving Techniques- managing and controlling time/space.
- PowerPoint presentation and lecture notes are used throughout the theory lesson.

11. 30 am. Transport will be arranged to take students from Proserpine State High School to the practical lesson on the day. A sausage sizzle will be provided on site, water and soft drinks also available, students are welcome to bring their own food and drinks.

The Whitsunday Regional Council and Police are closing Spruces Road from 12.00pm to 3.00pm each day for the purpose of the practical driving sessions.

The practical driving sessions consist of:

- Reaction times and stopping distances.
- Correct braking techniques
- Correct cornering techniques
- Posture and bracing
- Correct use of mirrors and correct use of eyesight in detecting hazards.
- Control of a vehicle in a skid situation.

3.00 pm. Completion of the programme. Students will be transferred back to Proserpine State High School by 4pm.

Assessment will be by oral and practical testing and a package of selected folders and booklets, which summarise the course, is given to each participant as "follow up" reference material.

A statement of attendance will also be issued on successful completion of the program.

The Rotary Club of Airlie Beach will provide refreshments during the practical driving session. This will include a BBQ and cold drinks.

Filby's Motors has generously offered the use of three vehicles to use for the practical driving sessions. There will be automatic and manual vehicles. These vehicles will be available for students to use for their practical driving sessions where no other vehicle is available. However it is preferred that the training is conducted in the student's usual vehicle.

Confirmation of your registration and date of training will be advised by mail or email with your payment receipt.
